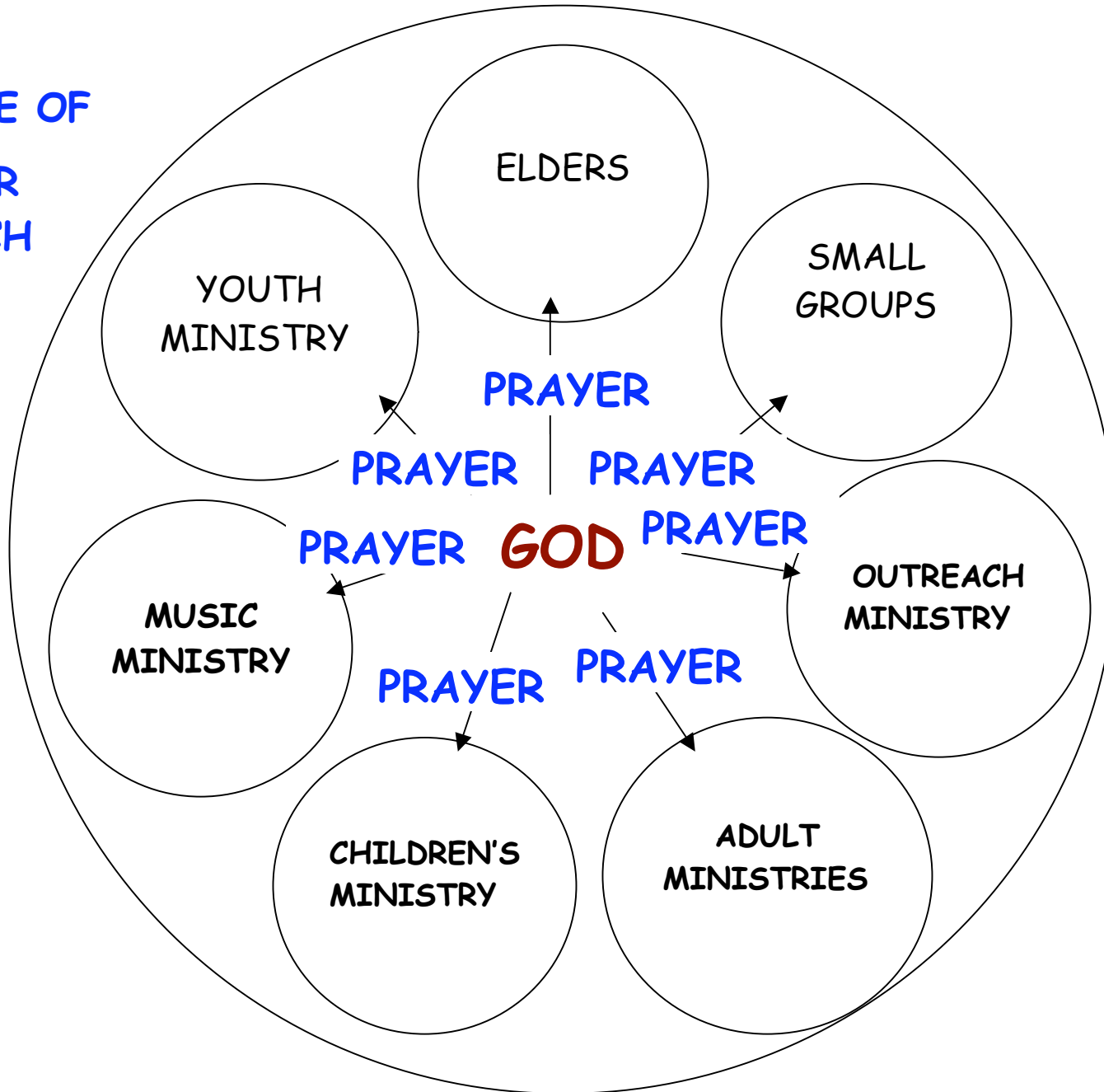
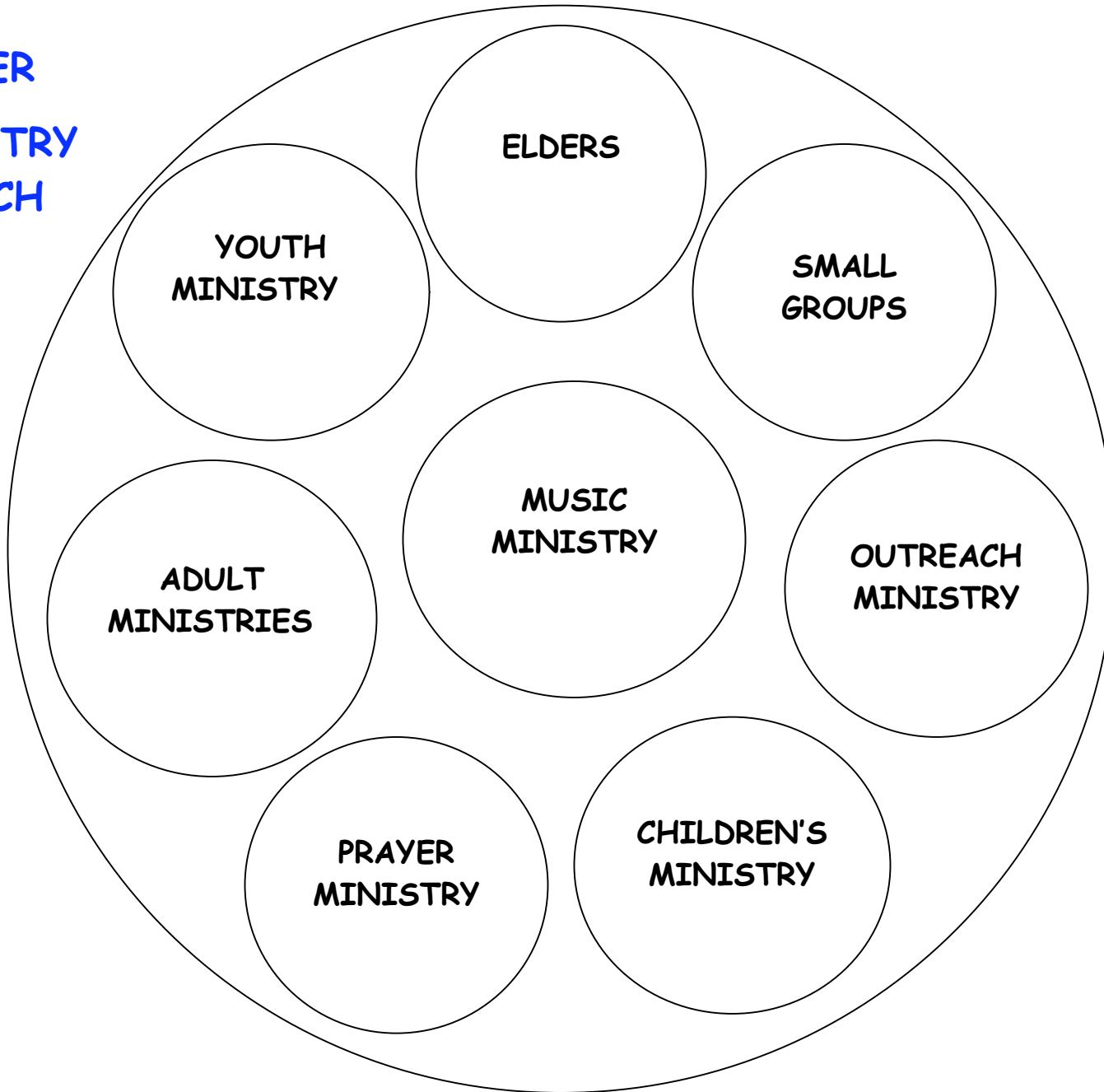

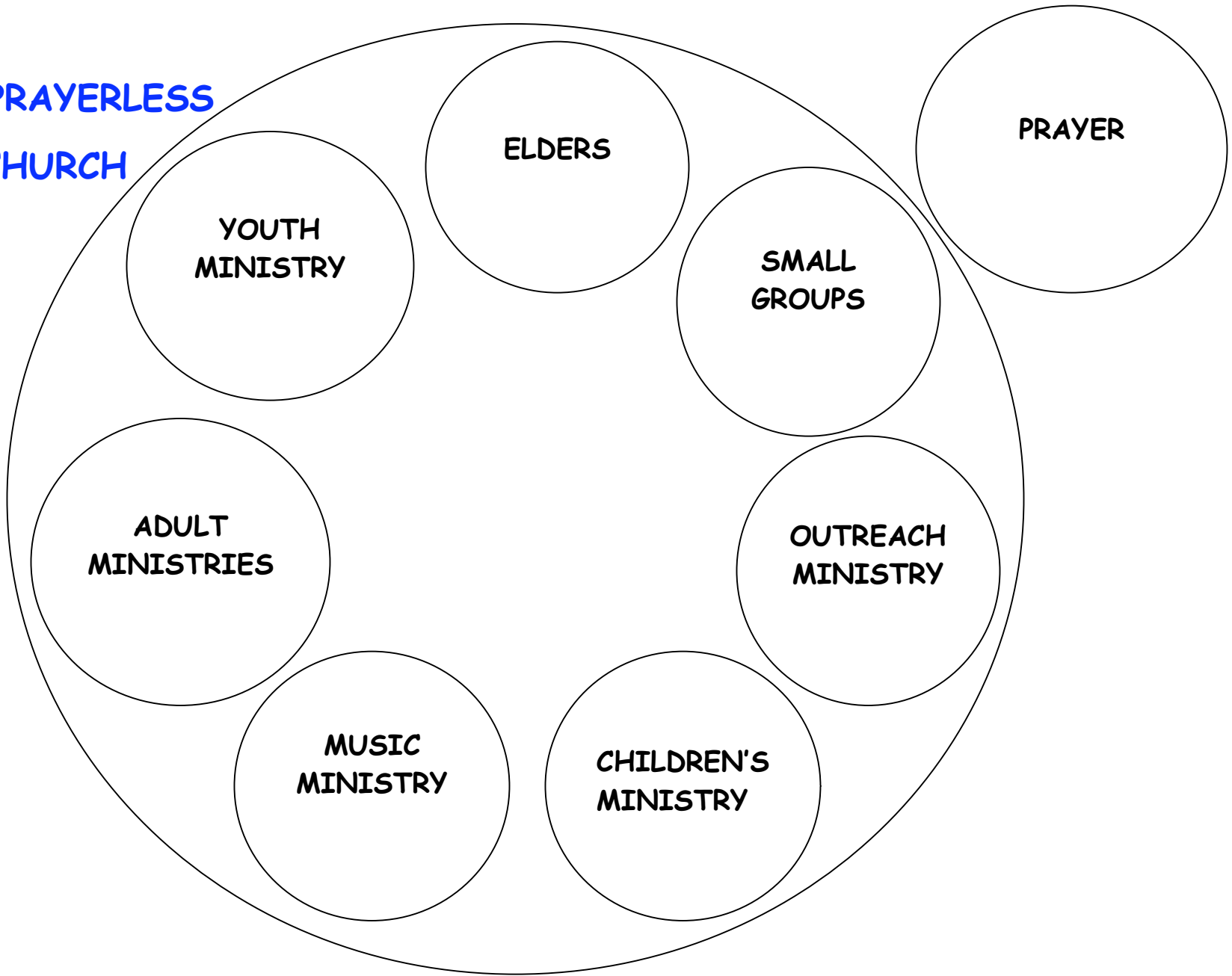

## Where Is Your Church?

### Church A

- Hardly recognizes the importance of prayer in its ministry.
- May open meetings in prayer.
- May have pastoral prayer in the worship service.
- May hold special prayer meetings at times for important issues.
- Prayer is basically outside of the ministry; it is not recognized as a ministry of the church.

### Church B

- Recognizes that prayer is important.
- Recognizes prayer as a ministry of the church.
- Some who have an inner burden for prayer are involved, but not many others.

### Church C

- Believes that nothing lasting will happen apart from prayer.
- Believes that prayer needs to permeate and saturate every ministry.
- Believes that every ministry must be prayed for, and that prayer must be a significant part of each ministry.
- Virtually everyone in the church is involved in prayer.
