Ministry Responsibilities:

1. Worship Celebrations

- a. Lead and Plan Corporate Worship Services
 - i. Work with the Lead Pastor to develop worship series.
 - ii. Work with the Lead Pastor to develop the total flow of worship.
 - iii. Use worship arts to help communicate the power of the gospel.
- b. Regularly evaluate all aspects of worship experiences with the Lead Pastor.
- c. Consult in the planning of worship for weddings, funerals, and other special occasions.

2. Worship Arts

- a. Recruit and train instrumentalists and vocalists as necessary.
- b. Work with volunteer staff to write, coordinate, distribute information and music, publicize, design sets and/or rehearse groups involved in productions (concerts, special worship events, etc...)
- c. Facilitate individual and team growth as worship leaders, dancers, drama leaders, and artists.
- d. Coordinate leadership, scheduling, and resources for worship arts.

3. Technical Arts

- a. Recruit and train volunteers to oversee audio and video ministries.
- b. Evaluate needs in audio and video equipment, as well as, the maintenance of the equipment.
- c. Oversee the use of the audio and video equipment

4. Team Responsibilities

- a. Our staff is a team. Therefore, every team member is expected to sacrifice for the team, rely on the team, give to the team, and defer to the team, because the team, not the individual, matters most.
- b. Trust is foundational to team. Therefore, every team member is expected to treat every other team member with respect and live and serve with each other in way that maintains a high level of trust.
